Dedication of Buena Park's Historic Town-Clock

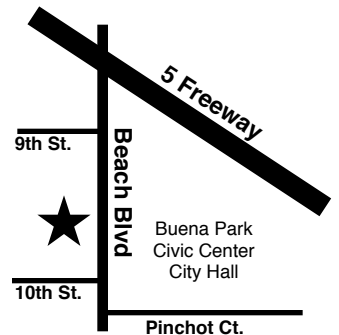
The 75 year old, newly restored, Dreger Clock from Knott's

This event will also celebrate the 225th anniversary of the first private ownership of the spring-fed oasis known as Plaza Buena, the origin of the township and city's name. The park and fountain next to the Whitaker-Jaynes House comprise the third location of Plaza Buena (1994), which commemorates the first (1784) and second (1887) locations.
